- *Have a fuller understanding of Digital Mammography from a Technologist's Perspective including some basic concepts, insights into some of the advantages and disadvantages of Digital*
- *Mammography, and an overview of work flow when using Digital Mammographic units.*
- *Have suggestions for overcoming Stereotactic biopsy challenges and be aware of new methods and equipment for stereotactic core biopsies.*
- *Read and follow post-biopsy instructions and appropriately employ patient-wrapping techniques.*
